### The NYS Common CORE Task Force Recommendations

The NYS Task Force made 21 recommendations supposedly to ensure quality education in the State of New York. Here are the major recommendations made by the Task force:

1. Common Core to be overhauled and to adopt NYS education standards with input from local districts, educators and parents.

2. Establish a process by which NY Standards are periodically reviewed by educators and content experts.

3. Create and release new and improved curriculum resources.

- 4. Engage NY educators, not private corporations, to drive review and creation of State standards-aligned tests.
- 5. Minimize student test anxiety b y reducing the number of student test

days and test questions.

A good start, but only a start. These recommendations are only suggestions not policy. There still remain a number of important issues not resolved.:

- The state is still obligated to Questar to create standardized tests until their contract with Pearson is concluded.

- Poor test scores can still result in schools being placed in which allows the state to take control of a school negate local contract and fire teachers.

- The four year moratorium on teacher evaluations and APPR is only temporary.

- The use of test scores as a major part of teacher evaluations is still a real possibility.

- Testing will continue for 3rd thru 8th grades.


- Testing of ELL students and students with disabilities still exist.






